



## Selection Policy for Open NT Teams

This policy is separate to the Junior Development Selection Policy

### Selection Criteria

All players must be a full financial member of a Golf NT affiliated club.

Maximum handicaps;

Male 6.4

Female 13.4

Note: Players with the potential to achieve these handicaps are encouraged to register their interest.

To be selected for NT representation you must have advised Golf NT directly or via your club Captain of your eligibility.

The Open Selection Group is made up of Peter Wright, Brian Pepper, Peter Hargreaves and Chaired by Jason De Araujo. These Selectors will make a recommendation to the Golf NT committee which may confirm their selection. Input from Club Captains is encouraged.

The Open Selection Group will look at nominated players score averages (if possible in comparison to other A grade players) and the events in which they play.

If at any time after the selection process has been completed selectors become aware of a selected player's indiscretion, the player may have their selection revoked and the selectors may select another player. Such selection shall be made with reference to selection criteria.

If at any time after the selection process has been completed, a selected player becomes unavailable for any reason, the selectors may select another player. Such selection shall be made with reference to selection criteria.

Such selection criteria may also include, but are not limited to:

Specific tournament conditions.

Past performances at major NT golf events

Note: a player not being nominated does not preclude them from consideration for selection in any NT Team.

### **Tournaments for 2009 and 2010 (subject to change after negotiation with international teams at the 2009 Arafura Games)**

#### 2009

Arafura Games (men's and women's) – 12-15 May.

Federal Amateur (men's) – October.

SA Event (women's) – September to October.

Victorian Mid-amateur (men's 35 to 55 yrs) – October.

#### 2010

Federal Amateur (men's) – October.

SA Event (women's) – September to October.

Victorian Mid-amateur (men's) – October.

### **Golf NT Obligations**

This will depend on approved Golf NT budgets and sponsorships.

- All travel and accommodation arrangements.
- Submit entry forms and pay all entry fees.
- Organise a practice round at tournament venue.
- Provide optional coaching in Darwin or Alice Springs prior to a tournament.



## Selection Policy for Open NT Teams

### Team/Player Responsibilities

Prior to event;

- Awareness of and commitment to the Golf NT Code of Conduct.
- Demonstration of appropriate on and off course behaviour abiding by etiquette as defined in the Rules of Golf.

To offset the cost of an event and/or towards the development of future NT Team events a \$250 levy will be imposed on each player. This may be waived for a local event where air travel is not required.

During the tournament;

- Conform to the rules set by the tournament conditions of play.
- Attend the tournament presentations as directed by Golf NT.
- Attend official functions organised by Golf NT and/or other State Associations.
- Maintain a high standard of conduct as a member of the NT representative team throughout the tournament.
- Specific meal and dietary requirements.

Prepare a written report for Golf NT after the event.

### Review Period

This policy will be reviewed regularly and any changes will be published on the Golf NT website and through Club Captains.
